

EWA Statement on EMF Directive Revision 3

2016 March 10th

- On June 26th 2013, Directive 2013/35/EU on the minimum health and safety requirements regarding the exposure of workers to the risk arising from electromagnetic fields was published in the Official Journal of the European Union. The transposition deadline for member states was set to July 1st 2016.
- The non-binding guide to good practices for implementing Directive 2013/35/EU was published in November 2015.
- In addition, the responsible IEC/EN product committee TC26 is in the process of harmonizing the existing CLC EMF product family standards for electric welding under the LVD.
- With the publication of Directive 2013/35/EU, EWA members started the assessment of their products, based on product family standards.
- EMF product information will be provided with the publication of EN 62822-1 on the list of harmonized standards under the European Low Voltage Directive.
